



## **II OPEN LOS MOLINOS Under 1600 and Under 2200**

**VALDEPEÑAS, 25th and 26th July 2020**

### **REGULATIONS**

Two parallel championships will be held in U1600 and U2200 modes. All players must have a federal license to participate in this tournament. If you do not have one yet, you can apply for it together with the registration form. Those players who are not in the list of federated players of the Spanish Chess Federation will not be able to register. This does not affect players from other countries.

For the U1600 mode, players with ELO below 1600 or without ELO FIDE can participate.

For the U2200 mode, players with ELO below 2200 and above or equal to 1500 may participate. Also may participate in this mode those players who accredit a "virtual" ELO equal to or greater than 1500, ie, with the computation of tournaments played in the month of July and will be counted in the following list of ELO FIDE equal to or exceed the established value

Players without ELO FIDE or under 1600 but with ELO FEDA over 1800 will be considered as players "in reactivation phase" and therefore will only be able to participate in the U2200 mode.

For this purpose, the FIDE and FEDA rating list of July 2020 will be considered.

The tournament is valid for ELO FIDE and FEDA. The Chief Arbiter will send an official report of the tournament to FIDE and FEDA.

Players who do not have a FIDE ID will be processed.

Players not accredited before 09:40 on 25 July will not be matched in the first round, even if they have paid the registration fee.

The displaced player will be considered that player who comes from the furthest town in Valdepeñas, for this purpose it will be confirmed according to the distances offered by the Google Maps App by the shortest route (Locality of Origin - Valdepeñas, without taking into account the exact address of the property). ID or other document indicating the player's address must be presented. If there is more than one player from that location or from the same distance, the prize will be awarded to the player who obtains the best classification in the competition

The category of Veteran +65 will be composed of all those players with 65 years or more, that is to say, born in 1955 or previous years and the category of Veteran +50 will be composed of all those players with 50 years or more and less than 65 years, that is to say, born between 1955 and 1970.

The age categories by ages are closed age groups, i.e. a U08 player qualifies for the U08 category but not for the U10 category, as an example.

To make the classification of the category Club the points of the four best players of the same club in each Modality will be counted. In case of a draw, the sum of the draws of each player will be used, applying the same order as in the individual classifications.

The Lots will be made up of typical products from La Mancha.

The prizes will be awarded in strict order of classification. If a player is entitled to cash prizes in several categories, the one with the highest value will be assigned. If the amount of the prizes is equal, it will be given in this order: General, Veterans, Aged and Displaced. Prizes are not cumulative.

All U10 and U08 players will receive a gift.

### **Registration and fees:**

**General** 20 €. + COVID fee = **25 €**

**Loyalty** 15 €. (Players who have participated in the previous edition) + COVID fee = **20 €**

**Members of Club Los Molinos** **10 €** (COVID fee assumed by the Club)

A **COVID Fee of 5 €** is established to deal with the implementation of hygiene and safety measures established by the competent authorities. Said Fee covers: the supply of surgical masks, hydroalcoholic gel, cleaning and disinfection material, medical control, ... and is mandatory for all participants. Los Molinos Club assumes the cost of said Fee for the Club's own players.

To avoid crowds, the mid-morning snack is suspended.

The registration deadline is advanced to July 20 at 22:00. In order to receive the medical questionnaires by the Medical Manager before the Competition.

Indicating name and surname of the player.

The possibility of making the registration payment at the time of accreditation is suspended, in order to avoid crowds and ensure that all participants send and deliver the medical questionnaire to the Medical Manager before the Competition.

Maximum capacity: 128 players Under 1600 and 64 players Under 2200.

Any paid entry will be returned if the player is not part of the Competition for any reason.

### **Place of Play:**

A change of the place of play has been made, to have a capacity that allows maintaining the safety distances established in the Competition Protocol. In addition to being able to differentiate the input and output circuit of the enclosure. The new location will be:

Pairings using Vega 8 JaVaFo engine (Swiss Dutch).

If any game lasts too long, the arbiter will be able to match the next round, giving partial results ( $\frac{1}{2}$  –  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) to the game in play and restoring the result once it is over.

## **Byes**

A maximum of 2 byes can be requested from  $\frac{1}{2}$  point for the first 4 rounds.

The player with byes must confirm this presence before the pairing of the next round to the requested bye.

The request of byes must be made in writing before the start the first round.

If a player will be absent from a round, he must inform the arbiter before the end of the previous round in order not to proceed with the pairing. Byes that have not been requested before the start of the first round will have a value of 0 points.

The player who is absent in the first round must deliver the original signed medical questionnaire along with the protocol of hygiene measures before the first round he wants to play. The rest of the participants will deliver this documentation before at the time of accreditation on Saturday 25.

### **Default Time:**

The default time is of 20 minutes since the arbiter started the round. A player who does not appear in the established time will lose the game by default.

### **Defaults:**

The default in 1 game without justification means elimination from the tournament.

### **Recording of the moves:**

The moves shall be recorded as clearly and legibly as possible, algebraic notation. Remember that with this rate of play you cannot stop recording at any time.

### **Electronic devices:**

#### ***Excerpt from the Laws of Chess (January 2018)***

*“11.3.2.1 During a game, a player is forbidden to have any electronic device not specifically approved by the arbiter in the playing venue.*

*However, the regulations of an event may allow such devices to be stored in a player’s bag, provided the device is completely switched off. This bag must be placed as agreed with the arbiter. Both players are forbidden to use this bag without permission of the arbiter.*

*11.3.2.2 If it is evident that a player has such a device on their person in the playing venue, the player shall lose the game. The opponent shall win. The regulations of an event may specify a different, less severe, penalty.”*

The arbiter will analyze what happened in each case and take the decision that he or she considers to be the fairest.

### **Tie-breaks:**

The following tie-breaks will apply in this order:

1. Brazilian Bucholz: sum of his opponents’ scores, minus the lowest.
2. Total Bucholz: sum of his opponents’ final scores
3. Progressive.
4. Number of games won.
5. Particular result.
6. 5 minutes games.

### **COVID-19 Protocol:**

The organization has developed a protocol to the COVID-19 pandemic on hygiene and safety measures to be implemented for this event, following the recommendations of the health, sports and government authorities.

Participants are required to read, understand and accept it. A signed copy of the page of the same must be delivered at the time of accreditation, and in the same way they should have sent by email the preventive medical questionnaire that will be reviewed only by the Medical Manager of the Competition (send the questionnaire to the email of the Medical Manager who It is indicated in the Protocol and in the mail received from the questionnaire) to determine its clinical assessment and risks before COVID-19, the original of this document must be delivered at the time of accreditation, filling in and signing the section where it is indicated that in the last days there were no symptoms. In other words, the form must be delivered via an almost completely completed email, except for this section, which will be completed and signed a second time on Saturday, July 25, and delivered to the Responsible Physician.

## Observations:

Everything indicated in Protocol COVID-19 for this event applies.

A player may not leave the playing room while the game is in progress or leave the board if a move is to be made without the arbiter's permission.

No analysis or reproduction of the games is allowed in the main game room.

Smoking is not allowed in the game room.

The Chief Arbiter of the Tournament will resolve any incident. The decision of the Chief Arbiter may be appealed to the Tournament Appeal Committee, whose final decision is final. Complaints, made against the decisions of the Chief Arbiter, must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Committee. No later than 30 minutes after the end of the playing session in which the event giving rise to the complaint occurred. The player who lodges a complaint with the Appeals Committee shall pay a deposit of 60 Euros, which shall be returned in the event that the complaint is decided in favor of the player. The decision of this Committee will not modify the result of the game in any case.

For anything not foreseen in these rules, this tournament will be governed by the regulations in force of the FIDE or the FEDA.

The participants authorize the publication of their personal data, as well as photos or videos in the different media that the organization considers appropriate (lists, classifications, games, etc.).

The organization reserves the right of admission, as well as, if considered appropriate, and always to improve the conditions of the tournament, make any changes or modifications to it.

The participation in this tournament implies the total and unreserved acceptance of the present rules and COVID-19 protocol published for this event.
